**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (PARKING AND
WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT No. 91) ORDER 2022**

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of their powers under Sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") as amended by the relevant provisions of the Local Government Act 1985 the Parking Act 1989 and all other enabling and amending legislation and enabling powers, and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:


1. This Order shall come into operation on 7 August 2022 and may be cited as The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) (Amendment No. 91) Order 2022.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The effect of this Order will be to:
 - a. Amend the existing unrestricted 2 wheel bays to fully on the carriageway on Wren Road at the following locations;
 - i. South side from a point 13 metres east of its junction with Porters Avenue for a distance of 18.5 metres in an easterly direction.
 - ii. North side from a point 16 metres east of its junction with Porters Avenue for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction.
 - b. Amend the existing disabled bays on Wren Road from 2 wheel bays to fully on the carriageway at the following locations;
 - i. South side from a point 33 metres east of its junction with Porters Avenue for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.
 - ii. North side from a point 10.5 metres east of its junction with Porters Avenue for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction.
4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2016 and the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Charged-For Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2016 shall have effect as though:
