## Special licence conditions for high risk foods and catering traders in Barking Town Centre Market

## Effective from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020

- 1. High-risk food and catering/refreshment stalls must comply with the Food Safety Act 1990 and Food Hygiene (Market Stalls and Delivery Vehicles) Regulations 1996.
- 2. The licence holder of a catering/refreshment stall must place a container provided for the collection of refuse immediately adjacent to the stall, ensuring that it does not obstruct the gangway between stalls, any other passageway or supply of services.
- 3. The licence holder must ensure that no electrical appliance used on the stall requires a current of greater than 16 Amps.
- 4. The licence holder must ensure that all waste water, oil, and fats are collected in a secure container and disposed of or discharged legally and in such a manner so as not to cause a nuisance.
- 5. Any stall from which non-pre-packed high-risk food is sold must be suitably screened from the risk of contamination.
