

Street Trading Regulations

Part I(a)

Special licence conditions for high risk foods and catering traders in Barking Town Centre Market

Effective from 1st April 2020

1. High-risk food and catering/refreshment stalls must comply with the Food Safety Act 1990 and Food Hygiene (Market Stalls and Delivery Vehicles) Regulations 1996.
2. The licence holder of a catering/refreshment stall must place a container provided for the collection of refuse immediately adjacent to the stall, ensuring that it does not obstruct the gangway between stalls, any other passageway or supply of services.
3. The licence holder must ensure that no electrical appliance used on the stall requires a current of greater than 16 Amps.
4. The licence holder must ensure that all waste water, oil, and fats are collected in a secure container and disposed of or discharged legally and in such a manner so as not to cause a nuisance.
5. Any stall from which non-pre-packed high-risk food is sold must be suitably screened from the risk of contamination.
