THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (LONGBRIDGE ROAD, DAGENHAM) AMENDMENT No. 78 ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce No Waiting At Any Time restrictions on Longbridge Road, north side, from a point 7.70 metres east of its junction with Lichfield Road for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Replace in part the existing Unrestricted Bay with No Waiting At Any Time restrictions on Longbridge Road, north side, from a point 13 metres west of its junction with Lichfield Road for a distance of 8 metres in a westerly direction.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 16 August 2021, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Councils website by visiting the following web page <https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/where-you-can-park> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes'.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
