THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (WAKERING ROAD AND THAMES ROAD, BARKING) AMENDMENT No. * ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce No Waiting at any time restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. Thames Road, north side, from a point 12 metres west of the entrance to Riverside Industrial Estate for a distance of 59 metres in an easterly direction.
 - b. Thames Road, south side, from a point 5 metres east of a point opposite the entrance to Riverside Industrial Estate for a distance of 28 metres in an easterly direction.
 - c. Thames Road, south side, from a point 5.5 metres west of a point opposite the entrance to Riverside Industrial Estate for a distance of 27.5 metres in an westerly direction.
2. Introduce a No Stopping at any time except local buses restriction on Thames Road, south side, from a point 5 metres east of a point opposite the entrance to Riverside Industrial Estate to a point 5.5 metres west of a point opposite the entrance to Riverside Industrial Estate.
3. Introduce an Unrestricted bay on Thames Road, north side, from a point 12.5 metres west of the entrance to Riverside Industrial Estate for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction
4. Replace the existing No waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6.30pm restriction with No Waiting at any time restrictions and No Loading at any time restrictions on Wakering Road, north-east side, from a point 2 metres north of the southern property line of No. 50 Wakering Road, for a distance of 16.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
5. Replace the Unrestricted 2 wheel bay with No Waiting at any time restrictions on Thames Road, north side, from a point 69 metres east of its junction with Gallions Close for a distance of 26.5 metres in an easterly direction.
6. Replace the No Waiting at any time restrictions with an Unrestricted bay on Thames Road, south side, from a point 18 metres east of its junction with Gallions Close for a distance of 45 metres in an easterly direction.
7. Revoke the existing Unrestricted 2 wheel bay on Thames Road, north side, from a point 12.5 metres west of the entrance to Riverside Industrial Estate for a distance of 19.5 metres in a westerly direction.

Barking and Dagenham hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE in exercise of the powers under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to;

8. Convert the existing Zebra Crossing to a Parallel Zebra Crossing and amend the associated zig-zag markings on Thames Road to the following locations, to cater for cycle movements:
 - a. North side of the carriageway, from a point 17 metres east of the entrance to Barking Business Centre for a distance of 35.4 metres in an easterly direction.
 - b. South and Central side of the carriageway, from a point 17 metres east of the entrance to Barking Business Centre for a distance of 39 metres in an easterly direction
9. Convert the existing Puffin Crossing to a Toucan Crossing on Ripple Road at its junction with St Erkenwald Road, to cater for cycle movements.
10. Convert the existing Zebra Crossing to a Parallel Zebra Crossing on St Pauls Road at its junction with Ripple Road, to cater for cycle movements.
11. Convert the existing Zebra Crossing to a Parallel Zebra Crossing on Axe Street at its junction with Ripple Road, to cater for cycle movements.
