The Council formally adopted the Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) – Last Orders? Preserving Public Houses on the 17 September 2014.

Last Orders? Preserving Public Houses (SPD) supplements policies set out in the Local Plan. The purpose of the Supplementary Planning Document is to explain the Council's overall guidance on protecting pubs.
