THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (PERMIT PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (AREA S10 CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE MG)

AMENDMENT NO. * ORDER 20**

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AREA S10 CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE MG) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 32, 33, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Orders, the effect of which will be to;

1. To amend the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2016 "the Free Parking Places Order" and the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Charged-For Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2016 "the Charged-For Order" to introduce a new Controlled Parking Zone - Zone MG to include the streets and parts of streets as set out in Schedule 1 to this Notice.
2. To implement permit parking, with some locations being shared use permit parking / pay by phone bays in the new area of Controlled Parking Zone MG, which will be operated and charged for under the provisions of the Charged-For Order, the current charges applicable being those set out in this Order.
3. To introduce the following restrictions within the Controlled Parking Zone MG, which will be operated under the provisions of the Charged-For Order and the Free Parking Places Order;
 - a. Resident Permit Holders Only (Zone MG) bays operating Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm
 - b. No Waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm restrictions
 - c. No Waiting at any time restrictions
 - d. Disabled Blue Badge Holders Only Bays
 - e. Shared use Pay by Phone (TC2) Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm Max Stay 4hrs No Return within 2hrs and Permit Holders Only (Zone MG) bays operating Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm
4. Off-Street Parking areas will be designated in the following 20 areas where "Resident Permit Holders Only Zone MG Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm" bays will be introduced; Coral Close Area Car Park 1, Coral Close Area Car Park 2, Coral Close Area Car Park 3, Reynolds Court Area Car Park 1, Reynolds Court Area Car Park 2, Nash Road Area Car Park 1, Nash Road Area Car Park 2, Nash Road Area Car Park 3, Nash Road Area Car Park 4, Nash Road Area Car Park 6, Cavalier Road Area Car Park 1, Cavalier Road Area Car Park 2, Cavalier Road Area Car Park 3, Cavalier Road Area Car Park 4, Gregory Road Area Car Park 1, Gregory Road Area Car Park 2, Gregory Road Area Car Park 3, Bardfield Avenue Area Car Park, Arneways Avenue Area Car Park, Padnall Road Area Car Park. Within these car park areas, where parking is not permitted it will be marked on-street with double yellow lines or yellow hatching and these areas must be kept clear at all times.
5. Off-Street Parking areas will be designated in the following 3 areas where "Resident Permit Holders Only Zone MG Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm" bays and "Disabled Blue Badge Holders Only" bays will be introduced; Gregory Road Area Car Park 4, Nash Road Area Car Park 5, Rose Lane Service Road Area Car Park. Within this car park area, where parking is not permitted it will be marked on-street with double yellow lines, keep clear markings or yellow hatching and these areas must be kept clear at all times.
6. An Off-Street Parking area will be designated in Highview House Area Car Park where "Resident Permit Holders Only Zone MG Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm" bays and "No Waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm" restrictions will be introduced.

To ALSO GIVE NOTICE that any proposed Orders that the Council has already published a Notice of their intention to make new charged for parking, which then comes into effect after the making of these Orders will

be subject to the parking charges as set out in these Orders and not the charges as included in any original Notice of Intention previously published.
