

# Road Traffic Acts

## THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (LOADING PLACES, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (COPPEN ROAD, DAGENHAM) AMENDMENT No. 94 ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce No Waiting at any time restrictions at the following locations:
  - a. Coppen Road, north and east side, from a point 14 metres north of its junction with Selinas Lane for a distance of 150 metres to its north-westerly extent.
  - b. Coppen Road, west side, from a point 14 metres north of its junction with Selinas Lane to a point 15.5 metres north of the southern property boundary of Character House.
  - c. Coppen Road, south and west side, from a point 23.5 metres north of the southern property boundary of Character House for a distance of 50 metres to its north-westerly extent.
2. Introduce No Loading at any time restrictions and No loading at any time restrictions at the following locations:
  - a. Coppen Road, north side, from a point 6.5 metres east of the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 2 Bakers Court in a westerly direction for 25.5 metres.
  - b. Coppen Road, west side, from its junction with Selinas Lane to a point 15.5 metres north of the southern property boundary of Character House.
  - c. Coppen Road, south and west side, from a point 23.5 metres north of the southern property boundary of Character House for a distance of 50 metres to its north-westerly extent.
3. Introduce a Goods vehicles loading only 30mins No return within 2hrs bay on Coppen Road, west side, from a point 15.5 metres north of the southern property boundary of Character House for a distance of 8 metres in a northerly direction.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on Monday 14 November 2022, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Council's website by visiting the following web page <https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/parking/parking-area> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes'.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
