THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (LOADING PLACES, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (HIGHBRIDGE ROAD AND FLEET ROAD) AMENDMENT No. 104 ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Revoke the No waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6.30pm restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. Highbridge Road, both sides, from a point 17.5 metres north-east of its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 33 metres in a north-easterly direction.
 - b. Highbridge Road, south-east side, from a point 8 metres north-east of its junction with West Bank for 15 metres in a south-westerly direction.
 - Introduce No waiting at any time and no loading at any time restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. Fleet Road, north-east side, from its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 4.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
 - b. Fleet Road, north-east side, from a point 23.5 metres south-east of its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 7 metres in a south-easterly direction.
 - c. Highbridge Road, north-east side, from its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 15 metres in a north-westerly direction.
 - d. Highbridge Road, south-east side, from its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 39 metres in north-easterly direction.
 - e. Highbridge Road, north-west side, from its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 47 metres in north-easterly direction.
- 3. Introduce No waiting at any time restrictions, south-east side, from a point 8 metres north-east of its junction with West Bank for 11 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 4. Introduce Loading only 8am-9pm 30mins No return within 2hrs bays at the following locations:
 - a. Highbridge Road, south-east side, from a point 41.5 metres north-east of its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 16 metres in a north-easterly direction.
 - b. Fleet Road, north-east side, from a point 4.5 metres south-east of its junction with Highbridge Road roundabout for 19 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
