THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (WOOD LANE, DAGENHAM) AMENDMENT No. 108 ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Introduce a Buses, cycles, motorcycles and taxis only lane in the southern lane of the westbound carriageway of Wood Lane, from a point 91 metres north-east of its junction with Gosfield Road to a point 153.4 metres south-west of its junction with Gosfield Road.
- 2. Introduce No Waiting at any time restrictions on Wood Lane, south-east side, from a point 67 metres southwest of its junction with Gosfield Road to a point 153.4 metres south-west of its junction with Gosfield Road.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 6 September 2023, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Councils website by visiting the following web page https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/parking/parking-area and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes'.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
