THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (CHEQUERS LANE) AMENDMENT No. 118 ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Introduce No waiting at any time at the following locations:
 - a. Chequers Lane, east side, both sides of the bell mouth, at a point opposite 26.6 metres north of its junction with Merrielands Crescent.
 - b. Chequers Lane, east side, from a point opposite 22.7 metres north of its junction with Merrielands Crescent for a distance of 5.3 metres in northerly direction.
 - c. Chequers Lane, west side, from a point 71 metres south of its junction with New Road for a distance of 18.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Revoke the No waiting at any time restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. Chequers Lane, east side, from a point 38.6 metres south of its junction with New Road for a distance of 34 metres in a southerly direction.
 - b. Chequers Lane, west side, from a point 9.2 metres north of its junction with Merrielands Crescent for a distance of 17.6 metres in a northerly direction.
- 3. Relocate the Bus Stop restrictions on Chequers Lane to the following locations:
 - a. Chequers Lane, east side, from a point 38.6 metres south of its junction with New Road for a distance of 35 metres in a southerly direction.
 - b. Chequers Lane, west side, from a point 9.2 metres north of its junction with Merrielands Crescent for a distance of 35 metres in a northerly direction.
- 4. Introduce Loading Bay 8am-9pm 30 mins No return within 2 hours restrictions at the following location:
 - a. Chequers Lane, east side in the layby, from a point opposite 42.7 metres north of its junction with Merrielands Crescent for a distance of 14.5 metres in a northerly direction.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
