

# Road Traffic Acts

## THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (DAGENHAM AVENUE, DAGENHAM) AMENDMENT No. \* ORDER 202\*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce 'No Waiting at any time' and 'No Loading at any time' restrictions at the following locations:
  - a. Dagenham Avenue, north-west side, from a point 15 metres south-west of the southern kerb-line of Hedgemans Road, for a distance of 19 metres in a south-westerly direction.
  - b. Hedgemans Road, south-east side, from a point 11.5 metres south-west of the western kerb-line of Heathway, for a distance of 27 metres in a south-westerly direction .
2. Introduce 'Disabled Badge Holders Only 4hrs No return within 1hr' bay on Hedgemans Road, south side, from a point 8.5 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Tilney Road (easternmost arm), for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction
3. Reduce the length of the 'Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8.30am-5.30pm 1hr No return within 2hrs' on Hedgemans Road, south side by 20 metres. The amended location will be Hedgemans Road, south side, from a point 1 metre east of the eastern kerb-line of Tilney Road (easternmost arm), eastwards for a distance of 7.5 metres.
4. Revoke the 'Disabled Badge Holders Only 4hrs No return within 1hr' bay on Dagenham Avenue, north-west side, from a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Hedgemans Road, for a distance of 19 metres in a south-westerly direction.
5. Revoke the 'Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8.30am-5.30pm 1hr No return within 2hrs' bay on Dagenham Avenue, south-east side, from a point 11.5 metres south-west of its junction with Heathway, for a distance of 27 metres in a south-westerly direction.
