## THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (KING EDWARDS ROAD, BARKING) AMENDMENT No. \* ORDER 202\*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Adjust 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions at the following locations around the new kerb build out:
  - a. King Edwards Road, north-east side, from its junction with Morley Road for 9.9 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- 2. Introduce 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions at the following locations:
  - a. King Edwards Road, south-west side, from a point 2.5 metres north-west of its junction with Morley Road to its junction with Net Street around the new kerb build out.
  - b. King Edwards Road, south-west side, from a point 1.2 metres south-east of its junction with Morley Road for 31.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 3. Revoke the existing 'Resident Permit Holders Only Zone J 8.30am-9pm' bay at the following locations:
  - a. King Edwards Road, south-west side, from a point 2.5 metres north-west of its junction with Morley Road for 15 metres in a north-westerly direction.
  - b. King Edwards Road, south-west side, from a point 1.2 metres south-east of its junction with Morley Road for 31.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
