

Statement of Reason

It is proposed to introduce an Experimental Traffic Management Order to replace the existing restrictions at Renwick Road/Bastable Avenue with new access arrangements for the local community.

This scheme has been developed following a comprehensive assessment of how best to meet the outcomes requested by the community, while remaining fully compliant with the **Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions (TSRGD)**, our statutory obligations under the **Highways Act**, and the legal frameworks available through **Traffic Management Orders (TMOs)**.

After detailed consultation with all relevant parties, including internal stakeholders and community representatives, the proposed approach has been identified as the most viable and sustainable option.

The scheme will be subject to robust monitoring once live. Real-time data will be used to analyse traffic flows during key periods (6am–10am, Monday to Friday), enabling targeted responses to any emerging issues. In addition, **Automatic Traffic Counter (ATC)** data will be regularly collected to monitor vehicle speeds and ensure ongoing compliance with the scheme's objectives.

An Order effective date of **3rd November** is both practical and strategic, coinciding with the return of schools from the Autumn Half Term. This timing supports one of the scheme's key beneficiaries—local families and school communities.

Summary of Justification

- **Community and Political Support:** Strong demand for improved accessibility for residents, addressing current hardship.
- **Environmental Benefits:** Reduction in emissions and improved air quality through traffic management.
- **Road Safety Improvements:** Engineering changes will enhance safety for all road users.
- **Congestion Reduction:** Eases pressure on surrounding routes, including the Healthy Active Travel Corridor on Renwick Road, linking Barking Riverside and the station.
- **Enhanced Local Connectivity:** Better access for Thames View residents to key destinations.
- **Improved Access to Services:** Facilitates travel to schools, health centres, and vital community hubs.
- **Future-Proofing:** Mitigates anticipated disruption from Lodge Avenue Flyover works commencing in 2026.
