**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER**

**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM  
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (BASTABLE AVENUE)  
EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2025**

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of their powers under Sections 9, 10, 122 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") as amended by the relevant provisions of the Local Government Act 1985 the Parking Act 1989 and all other enabling and amending legislation and enabling powers, and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025 and may be cited as The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Bastable Avenue) Experimental Order 2025.
2. This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months after it comes into operation or when a further Order to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provisions of this Experimental Order is made, whichever is the earliest.
3. The authorised officer of Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, may if it appears essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic on the highway, or in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the order runs, modify or suspend the operation of the order or any of its provisions.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
5. For the purposes of this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
  - a. "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;
  - b. "bus" and "local bus" have the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
  - c. "council" means the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham;
  - d. "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of the Act;
  - e. "pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

- f. "prescribed hours" means the periods specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order in relation to the streets or sections of streets specified in column 1 of that Schedule;
  - g. "provision of a universal postal service" and "universal service provider" have the same meanings as in Part 3 of the Postal Services Act 2011;
  - h. "traffic sign" has the same meaning as in section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; and
- 6. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter the streets or sections of streets shown in Schedule 1 to this Order during the prescribed hours.
- 7. Suspend the 'No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a Local Bus to enter Batable Avenue from Renwick Road between the hours of 6.00am to 10.00am Monday to Friday inclusive' as stated in Article 4 of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham East London Transit Route Prescribed Route Order 2009.
- 8. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall apply to:-
  - a. A pedal cycle;
  - b. A Local Bus;
  - c. Any Vehicles that are accessing properties on Batable Avenue and all adjoining roads between its junctions with Renwick Road and River Road including:
    - i. Alderman Avenue, Batable Avenue, Charlton Crescent, Chelmer Crescent, Crouch Avenue, Curzon Crescent, Endeavour Way, Farr Avenue, Glenmore Way, Havering Way, Hockley Mews, Job Drain Place, Laurence Calvert Close, Leslie Foster Close, Maud Gardens, Maybury Road, Pompadour Way, Radford Way, Radford Way Car Park, Ray Gardens, Rowe Gardens, Roxwell Road, Roycraft Avenue, Samuel Ferguson Place, Stanley Avenue, Stebbing Way, Sugden Way, William Hope Close and Wivenhoe Road.
  - d. a security vehicle or a vehicle bearing a livery which is used by a universal service provider and which is stopped at the edge of the carriageway for as long as may be necessary for the purposes of the provision of a universal postal service;
  - e. a vehicle being used for the laying, erection, alteration or repairs of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter any section of street specified in those articles;
  - f. any vehicle when used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter any section of street specified in those articles.
- 9. Nothing in this Order shall apply:-
  - a. To a vehicle being used for Fire brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;

- b. To anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
- c. To any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs places pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.
