**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (CYCLE TRACK)  
(LONGBRIDGE ROAD, DAGENHAM) ORDER 2024 (AMENDMENT NO.1)  
ORDER 2025**

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of their powers under Sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act"), Sections 65(1) and 66(4) of the Highways Act 1980 and of all other enabling and amending legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Orders shall come into operation on 11 December 2025 and may be cited as The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Cycle Track) (Longbridge Road, Dagenham) Order 2024 (Amendment No.1) Order 2025
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order.
3. In this Order, the "2024 Cycle Track Order" shall mean The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Cycle Track) (Longbridge Road, Dagenham) Order 2024.
4. Schedule 1 of the 2024 Cycle Track Order shall be replaced Schedule 1 to this Order.

Column 1 Roads/Sections of Road	Column 2 Direction of Travel
<b>Longbridge Road</b> , south-east side, from a point 15.74 metres north-east of its junction with Waterside Close for a distance of 139 metres in a south-westerly direction.	Westerly
<b>Longbridge Road</b> , north-west side, from a point 37.44 metres south-west of its junction with Meadway for a distance of 282 metres in a north-easterly direction.	North-easterly
