**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER**

**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (CYCLE TRACK)  
(LONGBRIDGE ROAD, BARKING) ORDER 2026**

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of their powers under Sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act"), Sections 65(1) and 66(4) of the Highways Act 1980 and of all other enabling and amending legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 29 January 2026 and may be cited as The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Cycle Track) (Longbridge Road, Barking) Order 2026
2. For the purposes of this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
  - a. "cycle track" means a way constituting or comprised in a highway, over which the public have the following, but no other, rights of way; a right of way on pedal cycles (other than pedal cycles which are motor vehicles within the meaning of the Road Traffic Act 1988) with or without a right of way on foot.
  - b. "footpath" means a highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only, not being a footway.
  - c. "footway" means a way comprised in a highway, which also comprises a carriageway, over which the public has a right of way on foot only.
  - d. "pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
  - e. "traffic sign" has the same meaning as in section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
3. The location specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order is hereby designated as a cycle track for use by pedal cycles travelling in the direction specified in column 2.

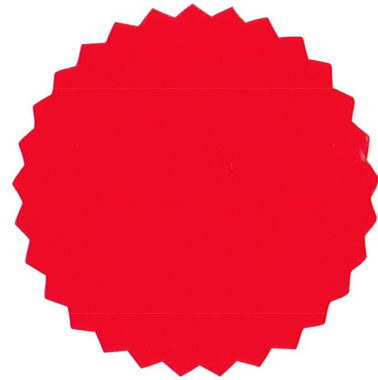

Column 1 Roads/Sections of Road	Column 2 Direction of Travel
Longbridge Road, south-east side footway, from its junction with Ventnor Gardens to a point 2.45 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 204 and 206 Longbridge Road.	South-Westerly
