Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)

Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) will be paid for children identified as meeting the relevant criteria. This is available for a maximum of 570 hours of the child's attendance per financial year. Early Years Pupil Premium: **£1 per hour**

Disability Access Fund (DAF)

Disability Access Fund (DAF) will be paid for children identified as meeting the relevant criteria. This is available once every year. Disability Access Fund: **£938.00 per year**

SEND Inclusion Fund
