HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 90A-F ROAD HUMPS AND THE HIGHWAYS (ROAD HUMPS) REGULATIONS 1999 INTRODUCE RAISED TABLES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham proposes to make the following traffic calming measures;

1. To introduce 75mm high raised tables across the entire width of the carriageway with 1:15 gradient ramps at the following locations:
 - a. Mayesbrook Road, from a point 10.5 metres south-east of its junction with Gainsborough Road for 24.7 metres in a north-westerly direction.
 - b. Gainsborough Road, from a point 5.9 metres north-east of its junction with Mayesbrook Road for 17 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2. To remove the existing round top speed humps at the following locations:
 - a. Mayesbrook Road, from a point 12.6 metres south-east of its junction with Gainsborough Road for 3.7 metres in a south-easterly direction.
 - b. Mayesbrook Road, from a point 10.1 metres north-west of its junction with Gainsborough Road for 3.7 metres in a north-westerly direction.
