**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (ELECTRIC VEHICLE
PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIOUS ROADS, BARKING AND DAGENHAM)
AMENDMENT No. * ORDER 202***

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of their powers under Sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called “the Act”) and of all other enabling and amending legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on _____ and may be cited as The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Electric Vehicle Parking Restrictions) (Various Roads, Barking and Dagenham) Amendment No. * Order 202*.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2016 (as amended) “the Free Parking Places Order” and the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Charged-For Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2016 (as amended) “the Charged-For Order” shall have effect as though:
