

Statement of Reasons

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham is proposing to introduce a **20mph Zone Speed Limit** and a **7.5 Tonne Goods Vehicle Weight Restriction (Except for Loading)** on the roads listed in the Notice. These measures are being proposed in accordance with the Council's duties and powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The purpose of the proposed Order is to:

1. Improve Road Safety

The introduction of a 20mph speed limit is intended to reduce vehicle speeds throughout the area and create safer conditions for all road users, particularly pedestrians, cyclists, school pupils, and vulnerable residents. Evidence shows that lower traffic speeds significantly reduce both the likelihood and severity of collisions.

2. Reduce the Impact of Heavy Goods Vehicles on Residential Roads

The prohibition of goods vehicles over 7.5 tonnes (except for loading) aims to prevent the use of these residential streets as cut-through routes by heavy lorries. This will help:

- Reduce noise and vibration experienced by nearby households
- Improve air quality
- Protect the structural integrity of local roads
- Create a more pleasant and safer environment for residents

Essential access for loading will remain permitted, ensuring that businesses and residents can continue to receive necessary deliveries.

3. Support Local and Borough-wide Transport and Environmental Policies

The proposed measures align with the Council's wider objectives to encourage active travel, promote safer neighbourhoods, and reduce the environmental impact of motor traffic. They also support commitments made under local transport strategies and London-wide transport and climate policies.

4. Enhance Quality of Life for Local Residents

By lowering traffic speeds and reducing unnecessary heavy vehicle movements, the proposals aim to create a calmer, safer, and more liveable residential environment for communities within:
