

Road Traffic Acts

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (7.5T WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (WESTERN AVENUE, DAGENHAM) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Prohibit all vehicles, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, from Monday to Friday between 8 am and 9.15 am to proceed along the following roads:
 - a. Western Avenue from its junction with Rainham Road South for its entire length.
 - b. Mayswood Gardens, for its entire length.
