THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (ROSSLYN ROAD, BARKING) AMENDMENT No. * ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions on Rosslyn Road, both sides, from its junction with Wilmington Gardens for 10 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2. Revoke 'Resident Permit Holders Only Zone E Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm' bays on Rosslyn Road, both sides, from a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Wilmington Gardens for 8 metres in a north-easterly direction.
3. Revoke 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions on Rosslyn Road, north-west side, from a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with Hulse Avenue for 4.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
4. Revoke 'No Waiting at any time' restrictions on Rosslyn Road, south-east side, from a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with Hulse Avenue for 9 metres in a south-westerly direction.
5. Revoke the Resident Permit Holders Only Zone E Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm bay on Rosslyn Road, north-west side, adjacent to No. 49 Hulse Avenue.
6. Revoke the Resident Permit Holders Only Zone E Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm bay on Rosslyn Road, south-east side, from a point 14 metres south-west of its junction with Hulse Avenue for 5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
7. Introduce 'No waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm' on Rosslyn Road, north-west side, from a point 24 metres south-west of its junction with Hulse Avenue for 2.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
8. Adjust the 'No Waiting at any time' on the south-eastern side of Rosslyn Road and south-western side of Hulse Avenue at their junction around the new kerb build-out.

Barking and Dagenham hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE in exercise of the powers under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to;

9. Introduce a Zebra crossing across the entire width of the carriageway on Rosslyn Road, from a point 10.5 metres north-east of its junction with Wilmington Gardens for 2.8 metres in a north-easterly direction, with associated zig-zag markings from a point 18 metres north-east of its junction with Wilmington Gardens for 31 metres in a south-westerly direction.
10. Introduce a Zebra crossing across the entire width of the carriageway on Rosslyn Road, from a point 10.6 metres south-west of its junction with Hulse Avenue for 2.8 metres in a south-westerly direction, with associated zig-zag markings on the central and south-east side of the carriageway from a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with Hulse Avenue for 14 metres, and the north-west side of the carriageway from a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with Hulse Avenue for 19 metres in a south-westerly direction.
