### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 90A-F ROAD HUMPS AND THE HIGHWAYS (ROAD HUMPS) REGULATIONS 1999 INTRODUCE SPEED CUSHIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham proposes to make the following traffic calming measures;

1. To introduce a set of 75mm high speed cushions at 1:4 side and 1:8 on/off gradients with a 3m length and 1.7m width, on Lodge Avenue at the following locations:
  - a. Outside Nos. 254 and 256 Lodge Avenue (set of 2)
  - b. Outside No. 211 Lodge Avenue (set of 3)
  - c. Outside No. 208 Lodge Avenue (set of 3)
  - d. Outside Nos. 150 and 152 Lodge Avenue (set of 2)
  - e. Outside No. 134 Lodge Avenue (set of 2)
  - f. Outside Nos. 116 and 118 Lodge Avenue (set of 2)
  - g. Outside Nos. 105 and 107 Lodge Avenue (set of 2)
2. To introduce a 75mm high speed cushion at 1:4 side and 1:8 on/off gradients with a 3m length and 1.7m width, on Park Avenue at the following locations:
  - a. Outside No. 16 Park Avenue
  - b. Outside No. 55 Park Avenue
  - c. Outside No. 71 Park Avenue
  - d. Outside No. 130 Park Avenue
3. To introduce a 75mm high speed cushion at 1:4 side and 1:8 on/off gradients with a 3m length and 1.7m width, on Park Avenue at the following locations:
  - a. Outside No. 9 Faircross Avenue
  - b. Outside No. 60 Faircross Avenue
  - c. Outside No. 66 Faircross Avenue
  - d. Outside No. 112 Faircross Avenue
