THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (CAR CLUB PARKING PLACES) AMENDMENT NO. 166 ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be:

1. To replace the car club CC1 permit holder only bays for Zip Car car club vehicles to car club CC1 permit holder only bays for Enterprise car club vehicles.
2. To replace the 'Car Club permit holders only' bays to 'Car Club CC1 permit holders only' bays for Enterprise car club vehicles at the following locations:
 - a) Abbey Road, east side, from a point 43 metres north of its junction with Linsdell Road for 12.7 metres.
 - b) Axe Street, north-west side, opposite Waterman Court.
 - c) St Erkenwald Road, north-west side, adjacent to No. 119 Ripple Road.
 - d) Salisbury Avenue, south side, opposite No. 51 Salisbury Avenue.

A copy of the Orders, which will come into force on 13 July 2026 and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order were made on the Council's website by visiting the following webpage <https://www.lbld.gov.uk/parking/parking-area> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes' or available for inspection at the Adult Library, First Floor, Barking Learning Centre, Barking between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
