THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (BOUNDARY ROAD, BARKING) AMENDMENT No. 167 ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called “the Act”) and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Amend the existing shared use ‘Permit Holders Only Zone GE Mon-Sat 8.30am-9pm/Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8.30am-9pm 1 hr No return within 2 hrs’ bay to a ‘Resident Permit Holders Only Zone GE Mon-Sat 8.30am-9pm’ for all bays within the GE Zone including the following locations: Abbey Road, Boundary Road, Dovehouse Mead, Gascoigne Road, Hardwicke Street, Linsdell Road, St Anns, St Margarets, St Marys, The Shaftesburys, Tomlins Orchard, and Wheelers Cross.
2. Introduce a No Waiting At Any Time restriction on the north side of The Shaftesburys between the junctions with Abbey Road and the northern arm of The Shaftesburys, behind the length of road where there is currently No Stopping on School Entrance Markings.
3. Revoke the No Waiting at any time restrictions, Disabled Blue Badge Holders Only bays and Permit Holders Only Zone GE Mon-Sat 8.30am-9pm and Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8.30am-9pm 1hr No return within 2hrs bays on St Marys, both sides, and to the north-west and south-east of St Marys including the section of land now owned by Greatfields School.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 3 August 2026 and the Council’s Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made on the Councils website by visiting the following webpage <https://www.lbdd.gov.uk/parking/parking-area> and selecting ‘New and proposed traffic and parking schemes’ or available for inspection at the Adult Library, First Floor, Barking Learning Centre, Barking between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
