TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

**THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM
(FOXLANDS ROAD AND RAINHAM ROAD SOUTH) (PRESCRIBED TURN)
ORDER 202***

The Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of their powers under Sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") as amended by the relevant provisions of the Local Government Act 1985 the Parking Act 1989 and all other enabling and amending legislation and enabling powers, and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The London Borough of Barking and Dagenham (Foxlands Road and Rainham Road South) (Prescribed Turn) Order 202*.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. For the purposes of this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - a. "Enactment" means any Enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an Enactment and any reference in this Order to any Enactment shall be construed as a reference to that Enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent Enactment;
 - b. "Carriageway" and "Pedal Cycle" have the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (as amended);
 - c. "Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham;
 - d. "Goods" includes Goods or burden of any description;
 - e. "Motor Vehicle" and "Trailer" have the same meaning as in section 136 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended);
 - f. "Traffic Sign" has the same meaning as in section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended); and
 - g. "Vehicle" means a form of transportation to carry people, Goods or both and includes Motor Vehicles, Trailers and Pedal Cycles;
4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, all vehicles proceeding in Foxlands Road northeast bound Carriageway must make a left turn into Rainham Road South.
5. Nothing in this Order shall apply:-
 - a. To a vehicle being used for Fire brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
 - b. To anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or

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- c. To any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by Traffic Signs places pursuant to Sections 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.
