THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (7.5T WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (MILL LANE AND SURROUNDING AREA, DAGENHAM) (AMENDMENT No. *) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Prohibit all vehicles, the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, to proceed along the following roads, except for access:
 - a. Beresford Gardens, from its junction with Mill Lane to its junction with Cavendish Gardens.
 - b. Cavendish Gardens, from its junction with Whalebone Lane North to its junction with Beresford Gardens.
