THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (BENNETTS CASTLE LANE, DAGENHAM) AMENDMENT No. 54 ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be:

1. Introduce no waiting at any time restrictions on Bennetts Castle Lane, north-west side, from a point 8 metres north-east of its junction with Lindisfarne Road to the south-western property boundary of No.154 Bennetts Castle Lane.
2. Introduce no waiting at any time restrictions on Bennetts Castle Lane, south-east side, from a point 6 metres south-west of its junction with Lindisfarne Road to the common boundary of Nos. 155 and 157 Bennetts Castle Lane.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on Friday 15 May 2020, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Council's website by visiting the following web page <https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/where-you-can-park> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes'.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
