HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 90A-F ROAD HUMPS AND THE HIGHWAYS (ROAD HUMPS) REGULATIONS 1999 INTRODUCE RAISED TABLES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham intends to introduce the following traffic calming measures;

1. 75mm high raised tables across the entire carriageway width at 1:20 gradient with a 5 metre plateau length, at the following locations:
 - a. Manor Road, from its junction with Rainham Road South for a distance of 8 metres in an easterly direction.
 - b. Crown Street, from its junction with Rainham Road South for a distance of 8 metres in a westerly direction.
 - c. Trefgarne Road, from its junction with Marston Avenue for a distance of 6.5 metres in a northerly direction.
2. 75mm high raised table across the entire carriageway width at 1:20 gradient with a 5.5 metre plateau length, at the following locations:
 - a. Keppel Road, from its junction with Wood Lane for a distance of 8.50 metres in a southerly direction.
3. 75mm high raised table across the entire carriageway width at 1:20 gradient with a 6 metre plateau length, at the following locations:
 - a. Marston Avenue, from its junction with Wood Lane for a distance of 9 metres in an easterly direction.
4. 75mm high raised table across the entire carriageway width at 1:20 gradient with a 18.25 metre plateau length, at the following locations:
 - a. Marston Avenue, from a point approximately 10.5 metres west of its junction with Tregarne Road for a distance of 21.25 metres in an easterly direction.
