THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (SUTTON ROAD AND FELTON ROAD, BARKING) AMENDMENT No. 68 ORDER 2021

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (ELDRED ROAD, LOFTUS ROAD AND WAKERING ROAD, BARKING) (ONE WAY EXCEPT PEDAL CYCLES) ORDER 2021

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (SHARED USE CYCLE TRACK AND FOOTPATH) (SUTTON GARDENS, BARKING) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Orders, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce No waiting at any time restrictions at the following locations
 - a. Sutton Road, south side, from a point 3.5 metres south-west of the western property boundary of property No. 28 Sutton Road for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction.
 - b. Felton Road, north side, from a point 5.75 metres east of Sutton Gardens western footpath, for a distance of 7.5 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Revoke the No waiting at any time restriction on Sutton Road, south side, from a point 3.5 metres east of the eastern property boundary of No. 26 Sutton Road for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.
3. Introduce a One Way Except Pedal Cycles restriction, allowing for 2-way pedal cycle movements at the following locations:
 - a. Loftus Road for vehicles travelling in a south-easterly direction from Tanner Street to Church Road.
 - b. Wakering Road for vehicles travelling in a south-easterly direction from a point 58.5 metres south of Gurdwara Way (A124) to Longbridge Road.
 - c. Eldred Road for vehicles travelling in a north-westerly direction from Sparsholt Road to Wedderburn Road.

Barking and Dagenham hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE, in exercise of its powers under Section 3(1) of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984, having obtained the written consents required by section 3(2) of that Act and in accordance with regulation 3 of the Cycle Tracks Regulations 1984 as amended, made the above Cycle Track Order, the effect of which will be to:

4. Covert the existing Sutton Gardens eastern footpath to a shared use cycle track, from its junction with Sutton Road to its junction with Felton Road, to cater for use by cyclists and pedestrians.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 3 MAY 2021, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Councils website by visiting the following web page <https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/where-you-can-park> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes'.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
