2011 Census Barking and Dagenham Ward Level Analysis

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1. INTRODUCTION

This report provides summary tables and main points taken from the Ward Level Key Statistics Census 2011.

The report is divided into general subject areas and provides tables with information for each of the borough’s wards, with a comparison with the whole borough and also with London. Key points are provided for each table.

Percentages are provided in each of the tables below. In some instances where it is useful to the analysis, numbers which are not included in the tables are referred to. The equivalent number tables are available on request.

2. DEMOGRAPHY

Usual Resident Population

- Abbey has the largest population of all LBBD wards at 12,786 residents. This drops to 9,839 for Parsloes ward.
- The gender balance for the borough is 48.5% males to 51.5% females. The proportion of males is slightly lower than that for London.
- The highest percentage of Males is in Abbey at 53.4%. This drops to 46.9% in Valence ward.
- The highest percent of Females is in Valence ward at 53.1% dropping to 46.6% in Abbey Ward.
- 99.5% of residents in the borough live in a household with 0.5% living in a Communal Establishment (such as a care home).
- Eastbrook has the largest percent of residents living in a communal establishment at 3.0%. This drops to close to 0% in Valence and Thames

Age Structure

- a. Abbey has the largest population in the borough at 12,786. The smallest population is 9,839 in Parsloes. This is a difference of almost 3,000 residents.
- b. Gascoigne has the largest proportion of 0-4 year olds at 13.2% in Gascoigne this drops to 7.2% in Eastbrook. The borough average is 10.0%.
- c. Gascoigne also accounts for the largest proportion of 0-9 year olds at 22.8% of the population, dropping to 13.3% in Eastbrook. The average for the borough is 17.8%, much higher than the average for London
- d. Abbey has the largest proportion of 20-29 year olds at 24.4% of the population, dropping to 12.6% in Valence. The borough average is 15.1%.
- e. Abbey also has the largest proportion of 30–44 year olds at 27.6% of the population. This drops to 19.5% for Eastbrook. The borough average is 23.4%
- f. Abbey has the lowest proportion of 45-59 year olds at 11.6%. Eastbrook has the largest at 19.4%. The borough average is 16.1% lower than the average for London.
- g. Abbey has the lowest proportion of residents aged 65 plus representing 5.0% of the ward population. Chadwell Heath has the highest proportion at 15.6%. The average for the borough is 10.4%, which is much lower than the average for London.

Marital Status

- a. Abbey has the largest percentage of residents aged 16 years and over who are single at 41.4%. Longbridge has the lowest percentage at 35.4%. The borough average is 38.8%
- b. The highest percentage of married residents is in Longbridge at 50.4%. Heath has the lowest percent at 37.2%, The borough average is 41.9%
- c. Abbey has the largest percentage of residents living in a same sex civil partnership at 0.6%. This drops to 0.1% in Chadwell Heath. The borough average is 0.2%, which is half the London average. There were a total of 276 residents in the borough living in a same sex civil partnership at the time of the Census 2011.
- d. Gascoigne has the largest percentage of residents who are separated but still legally married at 6.1%. This drops to 2.8% in Longbridge. The borough average is 4.1%
- e. Village has the largest percentage of divorced residents at 10.3%. This drops to 5.1% in Longbridge. The borough average is 8.7% which is higher than the London average.
- f. Chadwell Heath has the largest percent of widowed or surviving partners at 9.0%. This drops to 3.2% in Abbey. The borough average is 6.4% which is higher than the London average.

Living Arrangements

- a. Longbridge has the highest percentage of residents 16 and over living in a couple who are married or in a Civil Partnership at 47.2%. This drops to 34.9% in Heath. The borough average is 38.9% which is slightly higher than the London average.
- b. Alibon has the highest percentage of residents living in a cohabiting couple at 11.4%. This drops to 5.9% for Longbridge. The borough average is 9.9%, slightly less than the London average.
- c. Abbey has the highest percent of single residents not living in a couple who have never been married at 35.4%. This drops to 28.9% for Eastbrook. The borough average is 32.0% which is lower than the London average.
- d. Abbey also has the highest percentage of residents not living in a couple but who are still married at 6.0%. This drops to 1.8% in Eastbrook. The borough average is 2.8% which is about the same as the London average.

Household Composition (part 1 of 2)

- a. *This is measured in households, rather than number of residents*
- b. Chadwell Heath has the highest percentage of one person households aged 65+ at 14.8%. This drops to only 4.6% for Abbey. The borough average is 10.5%, higher than the London average
- c. For one person households aged under 65, Village has the largest percentage at 22.6% of all households. This drops by half to 11.7% in Longbridge. The borough average is 17.0% which is significantly less than the London average.
- d. Eastbrook has the largest percentage of Couples living together who are married/civil partnership with no children. This is 8.9% of all households in this ward. Thames has the lowest proportion at 5.2% and the borough average is 7.2%
- e. Longbridge has the largest proportion of Couples living together who are married or in a civil partnership with dependent children at 21.8%. This drops to 13.2% for Heath and the borough average is 16.5%
- f. River has the highest proportion of Cohabiting couples with dependent children at 5.6% of all households. This drops to 2.1% for Longbridge. The borough average is 4.4% which is much higher than the London average.
- g. Gascoigne has the largest proportion of lone parents with dependent children at 18.9%. This drops to 6.9% for Longbridge with the borough average at 14.4%. This is almost twice the London rate.
- h. Longbridge has the highest proportion of “other households with dependent children” at 9.9%, (This includes multi generational households). The lowest rate is 4.5% for Eastbrook and the borough average is 6.3%, higher than the London average

Occupations of Residents in Employment

- a. This section covers the occupations of borough residents who are aged 16 and over and in employment.
- b. The largest sector in the borough is that of Elementary Occupations at 15.2%. This is substantially higher than the London average. The range across wards is from 17.0% in Abbey Ward to 12.0% in Whalebone.
- c. The next largest occupation category in the borough is the Professional Occupations at 13.3% which is just over half the London figure. Abbey has the largest proportion of all wards of residents in Professional Occupations at 18.6%, dropping to 10.8% for Parsloes.
- d. The next largest sector, at borough level is Administrative and Secretarial occupations representing 13.1% of all employed residents. This is higher than the London average. Whalebone has the largest proportion of residents employed in Administrative and Secretarial occupations at 15.5%, dropping to 9.8% for Abbey ward.
- e. Process and Plant operatives are an important occupational sector in the borough, representing 9.5% of all employed residents. This is twice the London rate. Goresbrook has the highest percent of residents employed within the Process and Plant Operative category at 10.9%. This drops to 7.5% in Abbey ward.

Socio – Economic Classification (part 1 of 2)

- a. This section provides an indication of socio-economic position based on occupation and is a standard classification from the Office for National Statistics (NS-SeC). To assign a person aged 16 to 74 to an NS-SeC category their occupation title is combined with information about their employment status, whether they are employed or self-employed and whether or not they supervise other employees. Full-time students are recorded in the 'full-time students' category regardless of whether they are economically active or not. The rebased version of NS-SeC used in 2011 Census results uses occupation coded to Standard Occupational Classification 2010 (SOC2010)
- b. The largest socio economic group in the borough is 6. *Semi Routine Occupations* at 15.7%. This is much larger than the London average. Parsloes has the largest percentage at 17.4%, dropping to 12.3% for Longbridge.
- c. The second largest group in the borough is 2. *Lower Managerial, Administrative and Professional Occupations*, representing 15.3% of all residents aged 16 to 74. This is much lower than the average for London. Longbridge has the highest percentage at 17.9%, dropping to 13.0% for Gascoigne.
- d. The third largest group in the borough is 3. *Intermediate Occupations* representing 12.9% of residents aged 16-74. This is slightly higher than the London average. Whalebone has the highest percentage of residents aged 16-74 classified in Intermediate Occupations at 16.1%. This drops to 8.7% of residents in Abbey ward.
- e. 1. *Higher Managerial, Administrative and Professional Occupations* represent 5.1% of residents aged 16 – 74. This is 8.1 percentage points lower than the London average. Abbey has the largest proportion at 7.9%, dropping to 3.5% for Parsloes Ward.
- f. *L15 Full-Time Students* (whether economically active or not) make up 11.3% of all residents aged 16-74 in the borough. This is about the same as for London. Abbey has the largest proportion at 17.2%, dropping to 9.2% for Valence.
