Barking Town Centre Area Action Plan Adoption  
Statement 28 March 2011

This Adoption Statement gives notice that the London  
Borough of Barking and Dagenham resolved to adopt  
its Barking Town Centre Area Action Plan (AAP)  
Development Plan Document (DPD) on 23 February  
2011.

The purpose of the Barking Town Centre AAP is to  
resolve the land use implications of the Core Strategy  
within the action plan area and provide town centre  
specific policies in line with the strategic policies set out  
in the Core Strategy.

The Barking Town Centre AAP DPD was examined by  
an independent Inspector. The Inspector's report was  
published in September 2010. The adopted Barking  
Town Centre AAP DPD incorporates the binding  
recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the Barking Town Centre AAP  
Allocations may make an application to the High Court  
under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory  
Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is  
not within the appropriate power or that a procedural  
requirement has not been complied with. The application  
must be made promptly and in any event not later than  
the end of the six weeks from the date of this notice, i.e. 9  
May 2011.

Adoption Statement prepared in accordance with the  
Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes
