POLICIES DPD ADOPTION STATEMENT
9 MAY 2011**

This Adoption Statement gives notice that the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham resolved to adopt its Borough Wide Development Policies Development Plan Document (DPD) on 30 March 2011.

The purpose of the DPD is to set out the criteria against which planning applications for the development and use of land and buildings will be considered. The DPD provides the opportunity to cover matters in more detail than the broad strategy contained in the Core Strategy.

The DPD was examined by an independent Inspector. The Inspector's report was published in November 2010. The adopted DPD incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the DPD may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. The application must be made promptly and in any event not later than the end of the six weeks from the date of this notice, i.e. 19 June 2011.

The DPD, the Inspector's Report, this Adoption Statement, the Sustainability Appraisal Report and the Sustainability Appraisal Adoption Statement prepared in accordance with the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004 (16) (3) and (4) are available for public inspection on the Council's website at www.lbbd.gov.uk. Electronic copies are also available at the Council's offices at the Civic Centre, the Town Hall and the Council's libraries during normal opening hours.

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
