Core Strategy Adoption Statement 16 August 2010

This Adoption Statement gives notice that the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham resolved to adopt its Core Strategy on 21 July 2010.

The Core Strategy is the principal document of the Local Development Framework and provides the vision, objectives and spatial policies to guide development in the borough up to 2025.

The Core Strategy was examined by an independent Inspector. The Inspector's report was published in April 2010. The adopted Core Strategy incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector as set out in this report.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. The application must be made promptly and in any event not later than the end of the six weeks from the date of this notice, i.e. **27 September 2010**.

They are also available at the Council's offices at the Civic Centre, the Town Hall and the Council's libraries during normal opening hours.
