### **BARKING TOWN CENTRE (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) (ORDER 2010) AMENDMENT NO. 2 ORDER 2021**

### **THE BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (EAST STREET, BARKING) AMENDMENT NO. 58 ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

Amend the existing pedestrian zone on East Street (No access to motor vehicles except for loading between 6am – 10.30am and 5pm – 7pm Mondays to Fridays and 6am – 10.30am Saturdays only, no waiting at any time) so it extends from the junction with North Street to the junction with Ripple Road.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 11 January 2021, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Councils website by visiting the following web page <https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/where-you-can-park> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes'.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
